PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS). The Administrator has received a complete renewal application for a water pollution control discharge permit (Permit # NEV50028) from the following applicant:

Canyon General Improvement District (GID)
400 Canyon Way
Sparks, NV 89434

Canyon GID is a residential development located at the Lockwood/I-80 interchange on the south side of the Truckee River in Storey County. The Canyon GID Wastewater Treatment Plant has a design rating of 0.1 million gallons per day and services a customer base of 285 connections (870 residents) and seven commercial buildings. The sewage treatment plant, a modified Davco package plant treats the sewage to secondary standards plus nitrification/denitrification. Treated effluent is discharged to the groundwater via leachfield percolation. The treatment plant was constructed in 1985. The Division requires routine monitoring and reporting of plant performance in order to protect state groundwater.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the NRS as amended, and implementing regulations, the Division has made the tentative determination to issue (renew) the proposed groundwater discharge permit for a period of five (5) years.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, closing at 5:00 P.M. on **April 16, 2007**, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received by 5:00 P.M. on **April 16, 2007** will be considered in the formulation of

final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
