## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

April 18, 2007

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action in accordance with Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS). The Administrator has received a complete application to renew Permit NEV99011 for discharge from the following applicant:

Washoe County  
Department of Parks and Recreation  
2601 Plumas Street  
Reno, Nevada 89509

Permit NEV99011 authorizes the use of reclaimed effluent supplied by the Reno-Stead Water Reclamation Facility, NV0020168, for irrigation of turf grass and landscaping materials at the North Valley Regional Sports Complex at a flow rate up to 0.40 million gallons per day. The reclaimed effluent is treated to meet secondary standards, denitrified, filtered, and chlorine disinfected prior to distribution for reuse. Groundwater monitoring and discharge monitoring requirements are stipulated in the proposed permit renewal. Renewed permits, upon issuance, remain in effect for a five (5) year period.

Based on preliminary review of the NRS and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to re-issue the permit to discharge, subject to the limitations and conditions imposed. Comments or requests for a hearing, pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code-Water Pollution Control, regarding the proposed administrative determination(s) should be submitted, in writing, to:

Comments or objections must be received within the 30-day comment period, which begins on the date of this publication, and must be postmarked or received via facsimile or e-mail before 5:00 PM on May 19, 2007 will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s). If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. Public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date. If a hearing is not held and the determination(s) of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the

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Administrator will publicly notice the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
