NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection is issuing this Notice of Proposed Action under the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Division has received a complete application to modify the Water Pollution Control Discharge Permit NEV50028 from:

Sparks, Nevada 89434

This permit is for the municipal wastewater treatment plant serving the Rainbow Bend Mobile Home Park and Lockwood Mobile Home Park. The plant is now operating at capacity and the GID has just finished construction on a replacement treatment plant that will meet secondary treatment standards and denitrify. This new plant will have a capacity of 140,000 gpd. The existing disposal fields will be replaced by four rapid infiltration basins (RIB's) that will be used one at a time on a one week rotational basis. These RIB's will be used in combination with a reuse pipeline to the Lockwood Regional Landfill that will transport the effluent up to the landfill for dust control uses. This is the intent of this modification to the permit to allow the use of disinfected treated effluent for dust control at areas outside of the operating footprint of the Lockwood Regional Landfill and for irrigation at the Lockwood Park. The Division has made the tentative determination to modify the permit. Comments, objections, or public hearing requests on this matter must be submitted in writing to:

by 5:00 pm Monday December 28, 2009. Mail postmarked on that date will also be accepted. Hearing requests must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. Any public hearing would be preceded by a thirty day public notice period. If no hearing is held, and substantial changes are proposed in response to the comments received, a new public notice period would be conducted for the revised permit.
