PUBLIC NOTICE of PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Administrator has received a complete application for renewal of water pollution control effluent reuse discharge permit (NEV99002) from the applicant:

Tournament Players' Club – Las Vegas Golf Course
9801 Canyon Run Drive
Las Vegas, Nevada 89144

TPC – Las Vegas operates the TPC – Las Vegas Golf Course, an 18-hole championship golf course facility located at 9801 Canyon Run Drive in Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada. The permitted facility utilizes tertiary-treated, denitrified and disinfected effluent supplied by the City of Las Vegas' Durango Hills Water Resource Center wastewater treatment facility for spray irrigation of turf grass and plant materials on the golf course facilities and common areas. The Class B reuse water irrigation is done in accordance with the approved Effluent Management Plan and the terms and conditions of the permit. The permit renewal will be for a period of (5) five years.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to renew a permit to discharge, subject to certain effluent limitations and special conditions.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of publication in this newspaper by **October 26, 2009**, either in person or by mail or FAX (775) 687.4684 to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the applications. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permits, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date. If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
