NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection is issuing this Notice of Proposed Action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and the U.S. Clean Water Act. The Division has received a complete application to renew National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit NV0023256 from:

2827 Paradise Rd
Las Vegas NV 89109

The parking garage for Tower II at the Stirling Club at Turnberry Place extends below ground into the water table and is dewatered to prevent structural damage and nuisance conditions. Groundwater is collected by under floor and perimeter drains and discharged to a drop inlet on Paradise Rd. Although the discharge had previously been untreated based on a lack of contamination, recent detections of PCE have resulted in the planned installation of granular activated carbon (GAC) canisters. Limits for other constituents have been included as a precaution. The discharge reaches Las Vegas Wash via the storm drain system. The Division has made the tentative determination to renew the permit for a five year term. Comments, objections, or public hearing requests on this matter must be submitted in writing to:

by 5:00 pm Tuesday March 3, 2009. Mail postmarked on that date will also be accepted. Hearing requests must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. Any public hearing would be preceded by a thirty day public notice period. If no hearing is held, and substantial changes are proposed in response to the comments received, a new public notice period would be conducted for the revised permit.
