## **PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION**

Web posting 8/20/09

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and the Federal Clean Water Act. The Administrator has received an application for National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit NV0023728 from the following applicant:

The City of North Las Vegas (CNLV) requests an NPDES permit for the discharge of groundwater encountered during construction of the Southeast Interceptor sewer pipeline trench in Clark County, Nevada. The approximately 21,900 feet of pipeline will be laid along the following path: Pecos Rd., from Owens Ave to Lake Mead Blvd.; Lake Mead Blvd, from Pecos Dr. to Walnut Rd.; Walnut Rd., from Lake Mead Blvd. to Judson Ave.; Judson Ave., from Walnut Rd. to Lamb Blvd.; Lamb Blvd., from Judson Ave. to Alto Ave.; Alto Ave., from Judson Ave. to Betty Lane; Betty Lane, from Alto Ave. to the CNLV Water Reclamation Facility. The Applicant proposes to discharge the water, under specific limitations and requirements, to the Las Vegas Wash via Clark County stormdrain system. The discharge will be limited to 0.72 million gallons per day (MGD) and 2.16 MGD for the 30-Day Average and Daily Maximum flows, respectively. Based on a review of the NPDES permit application, the Division has made the tentative determination to issue the NPDES permits for each site for a period of five (5) years.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding the issuance of either permit, or to request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, hand-delivered or postmarked no later than **5:00 P.M. on September 21, 2009**, either in person or by mail to:

Comments and/or hearing requests received via facsimile or e-mail before **5:00 P.M. September 21, 2009** will also be accepted. All requests for hearings must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reason(s) why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day comment period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. The public notice of such hearings will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the public hearing date.

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If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
