Petition 2009-03: NDEP is proposing to adopt regulations that amend provisions of the Emissions from Engines section of Nevada Administrative Code Chapter 445B to align the motor vehicle inspection and maintenance (I/M) program with recent changes made in statute (A.B. 414). The changes expand Nevada's I/M provisions to include diesel-powered vehicles weighing up to 14,000 pounds; establish standards for testing emissions from reconstructed vehicles and trimobiles; and exempt certain trimobiles from emissions testing.
