Description of Proposed Permit Modification:

Nye County has provided a comprehensive update to the current permit application. Highlights include:

1. Update to the population, waste generation, volumetric disposal rate and projected landfill life.
2. A revised grading plan showing newly installed gas monitoring wells, improved drainage design and additional stormwater detention basins
3. New fill and excavation sequencing plans
4. Updated Closure and post-Closure plans
5. A new Financial Assurance instrument

Proposed Action

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) is proposing to approve and issue a Permit modification to accommodate the request.

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection's (NDEP's) Notice of Intent to approve a modification to the Permit for Nye County Public works (Pahrump Landfill) subject to the conditions contained in the Permit, will be published in the **Pahrump Valley Times**. Additionally, the Public Notice will be mailed to interested persons on our mailing list. The NDEP will accept written comments and written requests for a public hearing on the proposed draft permit from all interested persons. Written requests for a public hearing must state the nature of the issues, which the requester intends to raise at the hearing. Written requests for a public hearing and written comments on the proposed draft permit will be accepted until the end of the public comment period.

Will there be a public hearing?

The NDEP may schedule a public hearing on its own initiative or based on receipt of a written request received during the public comment period. Any interested person may submit a written request to the



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NDEP for a public hearing on the proposed action. The request must state the nature of the issues which the requester intends to raise at the hearing. If a hearing is scheduled, the NDEP will notify all persons who are on the mailing list or who have submitted written comments on the proposed action.

When does the comment period end?

The 30-day comment period ends **Wednesday September 16, 2009**. Anyone wishing to comment should do so **in writing prior to this date**. The NDEP may extend the comment period as deemed necessary.
