PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 445B, the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 445B, and the Clean Air Act, the Division of Environmental Protection is issuing the following notice.

The Administrator received an application to issue an operating permit for a Class I facility from the following applicant:

Newmont Nevada Energy Investment, LLC
450 TS Power Plant Road
Beowawe, NV 89821

The project is located in northern Nevada, approximately three miles north of Dunphy, Nevada in Eureka County. The Administrator has prepared tentative determinations regarding the operating permit that, in brief, are the following:

- One 242 MW pulverized coal-fired boiler
- Coal unloading, storage, reclaim and crushing operation
- One fly ash storage silo
- One bottom ash storage stackout
- Two lime storage silos
- Two recycle storage silos
- One activated carbon storage silo
- One multi-cell mechanical draft cooling tower
- One 1,504,000 gallon fuel oil storage tank
- One 50,000 gallon fuel oil storage tank
- One Diesel powered firewater pump
- One Emergency Generator

On the basis of the preliminary review and the requirements of the NRS, the NAC and the Clean Air Act the Administrator is hereby announcing his intent to issue a Class I/Title V Air Quality Operating Permit, AP4911-2502, based on a review of the information, as proposed. Upon a valid written request received prior to the end of the comment period, the Administrator will schedule a public hearing on the application and proposed action.
