Description of Proposed Permit Modification

- Industrial Wash Water Sump and Grease Trap Wastes
- Asbestos
- Coal Combustion Byproducts
- Water Treatment Plant Solids/Biosolids
- Pulp and Paper Solids

Proposed Action

The Division proposes to re-issue a permit for the acceptance of the above listed Industrial Solid Wastes at the Western Elite Facility. At this time, the Division is notifying the public of the opportunity to submit public comment on the proposed action whether to re-issue the permit as a final decision.

Will there be a public hearing?

The NDEP has scheduled a public hearing pursuant to NAC 444.6415, at the Pioche Town Hall on October 20th 2010 at 6PM. All comments received by October 29th 2010 will be addressed in final determinations regarding the application.

When does the comment period end?

The 30-day comment period ends at 5 p.m. on October 29th 2010. Anyone wishing to comment should do so in writing prior to this date. The NDEP may extend the comment period as deemed necessary.
