## PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

Web posting 9/3/10

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Administrator has received an application for renewal and modification of groundwater discharge permit # NEV2004524 from the following applicant:

Hawthorne Army Depot  
1 S. Maine Ave.  
Hawthorne, NV 89415

The Hawthorne Army Depot (Permittee) operates the Black Beauty Reservoir Water Treatment Plant (potable water supply for the Depot) in Hawthorne, Mineral County. The Permittee is authorized to discharge backwash water from this treatment plant to the groundwater in two infiltration basins. The Permittee has recently completed a groundwater treatment plant (supplied by two wells) for additional potable water supply. Filtrate, backwash and cooling tower blow-down from this new treatment plant are also proposed for discharge to the groundwater in the existing infiltration basins. The permit limits the total flow discharged to these infiltration basins at a rate of less than 100,000 gallons per day (70 gallons per minute). Adverse impact to the receiving groundwater is not anticipated from this discharge. The Division has made the tentative determination to issue the proposed discharge permit for a period of five (5) years.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, hand-delivered, e-mailed, faxed or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. PST on Friday, October 8, 2010, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time. The application, proposed permit, comments received, and other information are on file and may be copied or copies may be obtained by writing to the above address or by calling Mark A.
