PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

Web posting 3/24/10

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Administrator has received an application for groundwater discharge permit # NEV2010504 from the following applicant:

The applicant has proposed to construct and operate a 7,500 gallon per day (GPD) capacity domestic (sanitary) wastewater treatment facility located at the U.S. Army Reserve Center in Sloan (pop. 93), Clark County Nevada. Estimated daily flow of wastewater from this federal, military training facility is 5,700 GPD. Treated, denitrified effluent from the wastewater treatment plant will be discharged into a leach field with an estimated groundwater depth of 525 ft. below the ground surface. Monthly sampling of the effluent by a certified wastewater treatment plant operator is required. The Division has made the tentative determination to issue the proposed groundwater discharge permit for a period of five (5) years.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, hand-delivered, e-mailed, faxed or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. PST on Friday, April 30, 2010, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time. The application, proposed permit, comments received, and

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other information are on file and may be copied or copies may be obtained by writing to the above address or by calling Mark A.
