



## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Administrator has received a complete application for a new water pollution control discharge permit, #NEV2010513, from the following applicant:

The Waterhole is proposing to discharge treated groundwater from a former fuel dispensing station, located at 475 N. Moapa Valley Blvd., in Overton, in Clark County, Nevada. Former leaking underground storage tanks resulted in hydrocarbon contamination to the near-surface groundwater aquifer. The groundwater remediation project is under oversight of the Division's Bureau of Corrective Actions. Two groundwater extraction wells are used to pump the impacted groundwater to the surface for treatment. Current treatment includes a 4-stage air diffuser and two in-series 2000-lb carbon absorption vessels. Following treatment, the water is pumped into an on-site 10,000-gallon tank and is periodically removed by water trucks. The treated discharge is used for off-site dust control at a nearby sand and gravel pit. The permit is for the discharge of treated groundwater, with appropriate restrictions and conditions. The proposed discharge permit is for a period of five years.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue a groundwater discharge permit, subject to certain discharge limitations and special conditions.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control should submit their comments or request, in writing or by Fax, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, by **5:00 P.M. on November 8, 2010**, either in person or by mail to:

Comments and/or hearing requests received via facsimile or e-mail before **5:00 P.M. November 8, 2010** will also be accepted. All requests for hearings must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reason(s) why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day comment period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. The public notice of such hearings will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the public hearing date.

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within thirty days will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
