## PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

Web posting 7/22/10

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Administrator has received permit renewal applications from the following two applicants located in Amargosa Valley, Nye County Nevada 89020:

Longstreet Inn & Casino (NEV95004)  
4400 S. Hwy 373

My Own Mobile Home Park (NEV80013)  
4295 S. Hwy 373

The first applicant, Longstreet Inn & Casino, is permitted to operate a four-cell pond treatment system, which receives domestic wastewater from the property's casino, restaurant, hotel and RV Park. This first pond system is permitted for 40,000 gallons per day (GPD) and presently treats an average flow of 4,500 GPD. Disposal is by percolation and evaporation. The second applicant, My Own Mobile Home Park, is permitted to operate a three-cell pond treatment system, which receives domestic wastewater from a mobile home park. This second pond system is permitted for 10,000 gallons per day (GPD) and presently treats 1,750 GPD, equivalent from seven connections. Disposal is also by percolation and evaporation. The proposed permit conditions require monitoring and quarterly reporting by each Permittee to ensure proper pond operation and effluent treatment to Division standards. The Division has made the tentative determination to issue (renew) the two discharge permits for a period of five (5) years.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, hand-delivered, e-mailed, faxed or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. PST on Friday, August 27, 2010, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time. The application, proposed permit, comments received, and other information are on file and may be copied or copies may be obtained by writing to the above address or by calling Mark A.
