The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection gives notice that an application for a Reclamation Permit for a Clay Mining Operation named the Mustache Project has been properly filed with the Division of Environmental Protection in Carson City. The applicant for Permit # 0295 is:

This project is located within Lyon County, and is in portions of Sections 25, 26, 27, 28, 33 and 34 of Township 20 North, Range 24 East, M.D.B. & M, approximately 3 miles southwest from the community of Fernley, Nevada. The mine area disturbance consists of an open pit for the extraction of pozzolan clay located on public land administered by the Bureau of Land Management, Carson City District. Surface disturbances also include a truck staging area, salvaged growth medium stockpiles for mine reclamation, and a public/private access road with less than 2.0 acres of private land. No ore processing will occur at the mine site location.

The Administrator is constrained to issue the reclamation permit or to deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the reclamation permit.

Persons wishing to submit written comments or information on the draft of the permit must do so in writing no later than by 5 PM on May 14th, 2010. Any person who is directly affected by the application for a permit may request, in writing, a public hearing on the application for a permit. The request must state the reason for the request and the issues to be raised at the hearing. This request must be submitted, in writing, no later than by 5 PM on May 14th, 2010.

All comments, objections or requests received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding this Reclamation Permit. If the Division determines written comments or requests are reasonable and indicate a significant degree of public interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 519A.200. The Division will accept written comments in the form of facsimile, e-mail, or by mail. The comments may also be hand delivered.
