## INFORMATIONAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

### STATE ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION

The State Environmental Commission will consider and may adopt the proposed revision to the Class D Waters (NAC 445A.127); Smoke, Bronco and Gray Creeks; (NAC 445A.180 - 182); the Colorado Salinity Standard (NAC 445A.143); and the Snake Basin Waters (NAC 445A.214 - 225), at a public hearing tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, October 5, 2010 beginning at 10:00 am. The hearing location in Carson City is the [Bryan Building](#), 901 South Stewart Street (2<sup>nd</sup> floor, Tahoe Room). The hearing is tentatively scheduled as a video conference in Carson City and Las Vegas. In Las Vegas the hearing will held at the [Nevada Division of Environmental Protection](#), 2030 E. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption, amendment, or repeal of the above regulatory petitions and related SEC business.
