NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following Notice of Proposed Action under the authority of the Nevada Revised Statutes, the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), and the Safe Drinking Water Act.

The Administrator has received a major modification application for underground injection control (UIC) permit UNEV2007202 for the Blue Mountain geothermal power project by the following permittee:

NGP Blue Mountain I LLC
Suite 900 – 409 Grandville Street
Vancouver, BC Canada V6C 1T2

The permittee has submitted a major modification application for the 37.5 megawatt power production facility at Blue Mountain area near Winnemucca, Humboldt County, which is permitted for seven (7) injection wells.

The permittee is requesting an additional six (6) injection wells located in portions of Sections 1, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, & 35 T.36N., R34E., MDB&M.

On the basis of preliminary review, the Administrator has made a tentative determination to modify and reissue the UIC permit to add the new wells.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance or to request a hearing pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request in writing by May 12, 2010 either in person or by mail to:

All comments or objections received within thirty days of newspaper publication will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty days prior to the hearing date.
