Carlin Section 3 Exploration Project Permit #0314

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection gives notice that an application for a Reclamation Permit for the Carlin Section 3 Exploration Project has been properly filed with the Division of Environmental Protection in Carson City. The applicant for Permit # 0314 is:

Longmont, Colorado 80501**

This project, located within Elko County, is in portion(s) Sections 33, 34 and Section 35, Township 33 North, Range 52 East, Sections 2, 3 and 9, Township 32 North, Range 52 East, M.D.B. & M., located approximately 1.5 miles south from the community of Carlin, Nevada. The proposed 20.0 acre exploration project disturbance is located entirely on private land and has pre-existing disturbances associated with “historic” pre-1990 roads in addition to proposed exploration disturbances.

The Administrator is constrained to issue the permit or to deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the permit.

Persons wishing to submit written comments or information on the draft of the permit must do so in writing no later than 5:00 PM on December 14th, 2011. Any person who is directly affected by the application for a permit may request, in writing, a public hearing on the application for a permit. The request must state the reason for the request and the issues to be raised at the hearing. This request must be submitted, in writing, no later than 5:00 PM on December 14th, 2011.

All comments, objections or requests received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding this Reclamation Permit. If the Division determines written comments or

requests are reasonable and indicate a significant degree of public interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 519A.200. The Division will accept written comments in the form of facsimile, e-mail, mail or by hand delivery.

The draft Reclamation Permit and all application documents are on file at the Division office in Carson City and are available for public inspection and copying pursuant to NRS Chapter 239.010.
