NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 445B, the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 445B, and the Clean Air Act, the Division of Environmental Protection is issuing the following notice.

The Director received applications for renewal and modification of Class II Air Quality Operating Permit AP2491-0095.02 from the following applicant:

Nevada Wood Preserving, Inc.
1680 Spruce Avenue
Silver Springs, Nevada 89429

The project is located at 1680 Spruce Avenue, Silver Springs, Lyon County, Nevada. The Director has prepared tentative determinations regarding the renewed/revised operating permit that, in brief, are the following:

- X The renewed/revised permit is for continued operation of a wood products treating facility.
- X The proposed changes to the renewed/revised permit will change the company name from Selma Treating of Nevada dba Nevada Wood Preserving to Nevada Wood Preserving, Inc.; rename the three horizontal wood treating cylinders permitted in System 3; add copper azole type C (CA-C) wood preservative to allowable wood preservatives list and limit usage to 6 million board feet per year; add System 4, the Penta Block Dissolving System; reduce the annual HAP cap from 9.5 tons single and 24.5 tons combined HAPs to 2.0 tons single and 5.0 tons combined HAPs; and update the non-permit equipment list.
- X Facility wide emissions will not exceed 0.46 tons/year of PM/PM₁₀, 5.33 tons/year of NO_x, 0.03 tons/year of SO₂, 4.48 tons/year of CO, 25.62 tons per year of VOC, 2.00 tons per year of any single HAP, and 5.00 tons per year of any combined HAPs.
- X No adverse ambient air quality impacts are expected based on air dispersion modeling analyses.

On the basis of the preliminary review of the application and the requirements of the NRS, the NAC and the Clean Air Act, the Director is hereby announcing his intent to issue a renewed/revised Class II air quality operating permit.
