Re: Issuance of Revised 'Director's Review and Final Determination of Permit Issuance'  
Revised Class II Air Quality Operating Permit AP2992-1473.01  
Bango Refining NV, LLC (formerly Bango Oil, LLC; FIN A0511)

Dear Sir/Madam:

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Air Pollution Control (NDEP-BAPC) is providing notice that it is issuing a revised 'Director's Review and Final Determination of Permit Issuance' regarding its decision to issue a revision to Class II Air Quality Operating Permit AP2992-1473.01. The revised Permit and supporting documents are available upon request.

The initial Director's Review dated August 15, 2011 did not describe an increase in process throughputs that is allowed under revised Permit AP2992-1473.01. The revised Permit allows the hourly throughput of recycled fuel oil processed in Re-Refining Unit #2 (System 5B) to increase from 1,200 gallons per hour to 2,583 gallons per hour, but restricts the total daily volume of recycled fuel oil that may be processed to 62,000 gallons per day. Prior to this revision, Permit AP2992-1473.01 allowed the facility to process a total of 57,600 gallons of recycled fuel oil each day through Systems 1 and 5. Hence, revised Permit AP2992-1473.01 allows the facility to increase the volume of recycled fuel oil processed each day by 4,400 gallons, or approximately 7.6 percent. An appeal of revised Class II Air Quality Operating Permit AP2992-1473.01 may be requested pursuant to **Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 445B.360** and State Environmental Commission (SEC) administrative rules. Appeals must be received within 10 days of receipt of this notice, pursuant to **NRS 445B.340**; a copy of the SEC appeal form is enclosed.
