The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection has decided to renew Water Pollution Control Permit NEV0093115 (Permit) to Jetco Enterprises Inc. This Permit authorizes the construction, operation, and closure of approved mining facilities in Clark County. The Division has been provided with sufficient information, in accordance with Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445A.350 through NAC 445A.447, to assure the Division that the waters of the State will not be degraded by this operation, and that public safety and health will be protected.

The Permit will become effective **08 July 2011**. The final determination of the Administrator may be appealed to the State Environmental Commission pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 445A.605 and NAC 445A.407. All requests for appeals must be filed by 5:00 PM, **04 July 2011**, on Form 3, with the State Environmental Commission, 901 South Stewart Street, Suite 4001, Carson City, Nevada 89701-5249. No comments were received during the public comment period. However, since the date the draft Permit was issued for public comment, the Permit boilerplate has been updated to include spill reporting requirements more consistent with those of the Bureau of Corrective Actions and to require quarterly reporting of the status of any kinetic testing. In addition, a Schedule of Compliance item has been added requiring characterization of an ore sample and a make-up water sample due to possible laboratory errors in analyses for sample results submitted in the application. The issued Permit reflects these changes.
