The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (Division) has decided to issue Reclamation Permit, No. 0193, for an exploration project to West Pequop Project LLC (Permittee). This permit authorizes the Permittee to reclaim the West Pequop Exploration Project located in Elko County, Nevada. The Division has been provided with an application, in accordance with Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 519A to assure the Division that the Permittee will leave the project site safe, stable, and capable of providing for a productive post-mining land use.

This permit will become final June 26, 2012. The final determination of the Administrator may be appealed to the State Environmental Commission (Commission) pursuant to NAC 519A.415. The appeal must be filed by June 21, 2012, and in accordance with administrative rules of the Commission.

The amendment to the reclamation permit will authorize an increase of exploration disturbance acreage from 100 to 397.9 acres on public land for drill roads, overland travel roads, drill pads, trenches, monitoring wells, and a laydown yard. The amendment will also authorize an increase of disturbance acreage from 0 to 2.1 acres on private land for access roads.
