## **NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION - Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation**

**Lucky Boy Pass Silica Project  
Reclamation Permit No. 0310**

**James Hardie Building Products Inc.**

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) has decided to issue Reclamation Permit, No. 0310, for a Mining Project to James Hardie Building Products Inc. This permit authorizes James Hardie Building Products Inc. to reclaim the Lucky Boy Pass Silica Project. This Project is located in Mineral County, Nevada. The Division has been provided with an application, in accordance with Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 519A to assure the Division that James Hardie Building Products Inc. will leave the project site safe, stable, and capable of providing for a productive post-mining land use.

This permit will become final May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2012. The final determination of the Administrator may be appealed to the State Environmental Commission pursuant to NAC 519A.415. The appeal must be filed by April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2012 and in accordance with Administrative rules of the Environmental Commission.

The permit authorizes James Hardie Building Products to disturb and reclaim 17.0 acres on private land.

No comments were received during the public comment period.
