**Tipperary North Fork Exploration Project
Reclamation Permit No. 0325**

Concord Minerals, LLC

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) has decided to issue Reclamation Permit, No. 0325, for an exploration project to Concord Minerals, LLC. This permit authorizes Concord Minerals, LLC to reclaim the Tipperary North Fork Exploration project. This Project is located in Elko County, Nevada. The Division has been provided with an application, in accordance with Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 519A to assure the Division that Concord Minerals, LLC will leave the project site safe, stable, and capable of providing for a productive post-mining land use.

This permit will become final on May 8th, 2012. The final determination of the Administrator may be appealed to the State Environmental Commission pursuant to NAC 519A.415. The appeal must be filed by May 3rd, 2012 and in accordance with Administrative rules of the Environmental Commission.

The Tipperary North Fork Exploration project proposes 10.9 acres of constructed roads and drill pads on public lands in within the Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest, administered by the United States Forest Service (USFS).
