The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection (Division) has determined there is a significant degree of public interest on the tentative decision of the Division to issue a Reclamation permit for the Blue Diamond Mine. The applicant for the **Reclamation Permit #0328** (Permit) is:

This project will be located within Clark County, and is in all or portion(s) of:
Sections 25 and 36, Township 21 South, Range 58 East;
Sections 20, 29, 30, 31 and 32, Township 21 South, Range 59 East; and
Section 5, Township 22 South, Range 59 East, Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian.

The Division had previously published a notice of intent to issue the Permit in the Las Vegas Review Journal on October 16, 2012, which initiated a 30-day public comment period.

The public hearing on the application for the Permit has been scheduled to be held at the following location and time.

The hearing will include an overview of the Divisions permitting process and an overview of the project permitted disturbances and proposed reclamation activities.
