## NOTICE OF INTENT AND PUBLIC HEARING Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection (Division), Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following Notice of Intent and Public Hearing under the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Division gives notice that an application for **Reclamation Permit #0330** for the **Mount Hope Mine Project** has been received from the following applicant:

This project will be located within Eureka County, and is in the following sections or portions of land within the Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian:

The project will be located approximately 24 miles northwest from the community of Eureka, Nevada. The project will be a molybdenum mine and processing facility. The project proposes to disturb approximately 261 acres of private land and 7,992 acres of public land administered by the U.S. Department of Interior-Bureau of Land Management.

The Administrator is constrained to issue the Reclamation Permit or to deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the reclamation permit.

The Division has determined that there is a significant degree of public interest in this matter. Therefore, the Administrator is scheduling a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 519A.200.

The public hearing is scheduled for October 30, 2012 from 4:00 to 6:00 PM in the Grand Hall of the Opera House, 31 S. Main Street, Eureka, Nevada. The Division may set a 5 minute limit for oral statements based upon the number of people in attendance who would like to comment. Written comments will also be accepted at the hearing as they relate to any reclamation issues. All comments, objections or requests received during the public notice period and at the public hearing will be considered in the final determination regarding this permit.
