NOTICE OF INTENT - Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection (Division) gives notice that an application for a Reclamation Permit for a mining project, named the **Pumpkin Hollow Project**, has been properly filed with the Division in Carson City. The applicant for Permit 0288 is:

This project, will be located within Lyon County, Section 35, Township 13 North, Range 26 East and in Sections 2-4, and 9-11 of Township 12 North, Range 26 East, M.D.B. & M, approximately eight (8) miles southeast from the community of Yerington, Nevada. The mine components include an underground shaft-head frame, a mine waste rock storage facility, water infiltration management basins, exploration disturbances and ore processing support infrastructure facilities.

The Administrator is constrained to issue the Reclamation Permit or to deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the reclamation permit.

Persons wishing to submit written comments or information on the draft of the permit must do so in writing no later than by 5 PM on May 31st, 2013. Any person who is directly affected by the application for a permit may request, in writing, a public hearing on the application for a permit. The request must state the reason for the request and the issues to be raised at the hearing. This request must be submitted, in writing, no later than by 5 PM on May 31st, 2013.

All comments, objections or requests received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding this Reclamation Permit. If the Division

determines written comments or requests are reasonable and indicate a significant degree of public interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 519A.200. The Division will accept written comments in the form of facsimile, e-mail, or by mail. The comments may also be hand delivered.

The draft Reclamation Permit and all application documents are on file at the Division and are available for public inspection and copying pursuant to NRS Chapter 239.010.
