NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and/or the Clean Water Act, where applicable. The Administrator has received an application for a Groundwater Discharge, permit number NS0087045 from the following applicant:

Permit NS0087045, PANACA FARMSTEAD ASSOCIATION WWTF:

The applicant, Panaca Farmstead Association (PFA), has applied for renewal of groundwater discharge permit NS0087045 (formerly NV87045). PFA owns and operates a facultative pond wastewater treatment facility located on the east side of Panaca, just south of State Route 319. In 2011, PFA completed several upgrades to the treatment system including wet-well and force main replacement, treatment pond grading and lining, and the conversion of their disposal pond into three (3) rapid infiltration basins. The facility now includes one lift station, three HDPE lined facultative ponds, three rapid infiltration basins, and one monitoring well. The Permittee has requested a 30-day average flow of 0.08 million gallons per day (MGD) and a maximum flow of 0.1 MGD. Upon a request from the Permittee, and following Division approval, the daily average and maximum daily flow rates may be increased up to the treatment facility's actual design capacity. This increase will be considered a minor permit modification.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue Permit NS0087045 to discharge for a five (5) year period, subject to certain effluent limitations.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, hand delivered or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. on 06/24/2013, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s) regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the

tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
