NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and/or the Clean Water Act, where applicable. The Administrator has received an application for a Groundwater Discharge, permit number NS0096020 from the following applicant:

Permit NS0096020, BONANZA-MOJAVE WATER RESOURCE CENTER:

The City of Las Vegas (City) operates the Bonanza-Mojave Water Resource Center (BMWRC), a 1.1 million gallon per day satellite wastewater treatment facility located at 650 N. Mojave Road, Las Vegas, NV. BMWRC provides reuse Category B treated effluent to the Desert Pines Golf Club (NEV96019) for landscape and turf irrigation. Effluent flows in excess of the irrigation demand at the golf course, as well as waste activated sludge generated at BMWRC, are returned to the sanitary sewer for further treatment at the City of Las Vegas Water Pollution Control Facility (LVWPCF) which discharges under Bureau of Water Pollution Control permits NV0020133 and NS0098015. The City eventually plans to retire this plant at which time effluent for Desert Pines Golf Club will be provided by the LVWPCF.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue Permit NS0096020 to discharge for a five (5) year period, subject to certain effluent limitations.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, hand delivered or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. on 01/21/2014, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s) regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
