## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and/or the Clean Water Act, where applicable. The Administrator has received an application for a Manufacturing, Commercial, Mining and Silvicultural facility that discharges NON-PROCESS Wastewater, permit number NV0024206 from the following applicant:

### Permit NV0024206, THE WATERHOLE:

The Waterhole is proposing to discharge treated groundwater from a former fuel dispensing station, located at 475 North Moapa Valley Boulevard, Overton, Clark County, Nevada. Groundwater below the site has been impacted with petroleum hydrocarbons due to a gasoline leak from underground storage tanks. The impacted groundwater is processed through an oil/water separator, 4-stage air diffuser and three in-series 2000-lb carbon absorption vessels. The treated groundwater is discharged to a roadway culvert which is routed to the Muddy River. The proposed 30-day average and daily maximum discharge rates are 0.0432 million gallons per day (MGD).

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue Permit NV0024206 to discharge for a five (5) year period, subject to certain effluent limitations.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, hand delivered or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. on 05/10/2013, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s) regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
