## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Nevada Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the authority of the Nevada Revised Statutes and the Safe Drinking Water Act.

The Administrator has received a renewal application for Underground Injection Control (UIC) permit UNEV90001, which has been drafted for public comment, has been applied for by the following applicant:

The applicant requests to renew permit UNEV90001 to allow the injection of potable, treated Colorado River water provided by the Southern Nevada Water System into five (5) wells in the Las Vegas Valley aquifer located within Section 12, T20S; R60E and Sections 6, 17, 18, 20, T20S; R61E, MDB&M, within the City of North Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada. The applicant plans to inject the water during the fall and winter months when excess capacity exists in the water distribution system and then withdraw the water during the summer months when the peak seasonal demand occurs. Monitoring and sampling will occur to ensure injected water meets all primary drinking water standards.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes and the Safe Drinking Water Act, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to renew permit UNEV90001 as stated above.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit renewal or to request a hearing pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request in writing by December 4, 2013 either in person or by mail to:

All comments or objections received within thirty days of newspaper publication will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty days prior to the hearing date.
