NOTICE OF INTENT - Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection (Division) gives notice that an application to modify the Reclamation Permit for the **Churchill Limestone Quarry** has been properly filed with the Division of Environmental Protection in Carson City. The applicant for Permit # 0104 is:

The existing mine site is located within Churchill County, in Sections 31, 32 of Township 25 North, Range 29 East; and includes an access haul road in Sections 6, 7, 17 and 18 of Township 24 North, Range 29 East; M.D.B. & M, on both public and private lands approximately 40 miles northeast from the community of Fernley, Nevada. This notice of permit modification proposes a pit expansion, an additional waste rock storage facility, haul road, diversion channel and landfill.

The Administrator is constrained to issue the Reclamation Permit or to deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the reclamation permit.

Persons wishing to submit written comments or information on the draft of the permit must do so in writing no later than by 5 PM on November 10th, 2014. Any person who is directly affected by the application for a permit may request, in writing, a public hearing on the application for a permit. The request must state the reason for the request and the issues to be raised at the hearing. This request must be submitted, in writing, no later than by 5 PM on November 10th, 2014 to:

All comments, objections or requests received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding this Reclamation Permit. If the Division determines written comments or requests are reasonable and indicate a significant degree of

public interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 519A.200. The Division will accept written comments in the form of facsimile, e-mail, or by mail. The comments may also be hand delivered.

The draft Reclamation Permit and all application documents are on file at the Division and are available for public inspection and copying pursuant to NRS Chapter 239.010.
