**North Bullion Exploration Project
Reclamation Permit 0329
Gold Standard Ventures Corporation**

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (Division) has decided to issue Reclamation Permit 0329, for an exploration project to Gold Standard Ventures Corporation (Permittee). This permit authorizes the Permittee to reclaim the North Bullion Exploration Project located in Elko County, Nevada. The Division has been provided with an application, in accordance with Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and Nevada Administrative Code (NC) 519A to assure the Division that the Permittee will leave the project site safe, stable, and capable of providing for a productive post-mining land use.

This permit will become final June 14, 2014. The final determination of the Administrator may be appealed to the State Environmental Commission (Commission) pursuant to NAC 519A.415. All requests for appeals must be filed by 5:00pm, June 9, 2014, on Form 3 with the Commission at 901 S. Stewart Street, Suite 4001, Carson City, NV 89701-5249, and in accordance with administrative rules of the Commission

The North Bullion Exploration Project is an exploration project proposing to disturb 39.5 acres of private land and has pre-existing disturbances associated with "historic" pre-1990 roads in addition to proposed exploration disturbances. Exploration disturbance will consist of constructed roads, drill pads, sumps, an infiltration pond and staging yards.
