NOTICE OF INTENT - Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection (Division) gives notice that an application for a Reclamation Permit for a mining operation for the **Coyote Blossom Mine** has been properly filed with the Division in Carson City. The applicant for Permit 0358 is:

This project, will be located within Clark County, and is in portion(s) of Sections 14, 15, 22, and 23, Township 28 South, Range 63 East, M.D.B. & M, approximately one and half miles from the community of Searchlight, Nevada. This mining project combines two existing adjacent underground mines, the Coyote and Blossom mines, into one project. The project will expand existing facilities and will include a new portal decline and gravity separation process facilities. Total project disturbance is 29.4 acres all on private land.

The Administrator is constrained to issue the Reclamation Permit or to deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the reclamation permit.

Persons wishing to submit written comments or information on the draft of the permit must do so in writing no later than by 5 PM on June 13, 2014. Any person who is directly affected by the application for a permit may request, in writing, a public hearing on the application for a permit. The request must state the reason for the request and the issues to be raised at the hearing. This request must be submitted, in writing, no later than by 5 PM on June 13, 2014.

All comments, objections or requests received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding this Reclamation Permit. If the Division determines written comments or requests are reasonable and indicate a significant degree of

public interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 519A.200. The Division will accept written comments in the form of facsimile, e-mail, or by mail. The comments may also be hand delivered.

The draft Reclamation Permit and all application documents are on file at the Division and are available for public inspection and copying pursuant to NRS Chapter 239.010.
