## PUBLIC NOTICE

The Administrator of the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (Division) gives notice, under the Nevada Revised Statutes 444.440 through 444.620, inclusive, and under the Nevada Administrative Code 444.570 through 444.7499, inclusive, that the Division has received a request to modify Permit SW224 to construct and operate a Class I and Class III Landfill from the following applicant:

### **City of Ely (Ely City Class I and Class III Landfill)**

The City of Ely has requested to modify the existing Class I and Class III Municipal Solid Waste Landfill approximately 1 mile north of Ely, Nevada. The proposed modification includes a change in the landfill footprint, with a net increase of 10 acres and a height increase of 30 feet for the Class III portion of the landfill, and the addition of stormwater management ditches and ponds. The Administrator is constrained to either issue the modified permit or deny the request in accordance with NAC 444.641. The Administrator is issuing this notice of intent to issue the modified Permit to the applicant.

The applicant or any interested persons may submit written comments on this proposed intent by the Administrator regarding permit issuance. Written comments must be submitted **no later than 5:00 pm on January 5<sup>th</sup> 2015** to:

The Draft Permit, Fact Sheet and Application for modification are available for review at the above address and on the Division website <http://ndep.nv.gov/admin/public.htm#waste>. A statement responding to all comments received will be issued. Copies of the statement will be sent to the applicant, person(s) who submitted written comments, and all other persons who specifically request, in writing, a copy of the statement. The Administrator may extend the period for public comment as necessary.

Within 30 days after the end of the public review period, the Administrator will either issue or deny the permit to operate the disposal site, or may modify, or place conditions on, the permit issued in accordance with NAC 444.6425.
