



NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following Notice of Proposed Action under the authority of the Nevada Revised Statutes, the Nevada Administrative Code, and the Safe Drinking Water Act.

The Administrator has received a renewal application for an Underground Injection Control (UIC) permit UNEV89006, which has been drafted for public comment, from the following applicant:

UNEV89006 authorizes injection of produced fluids and ambient air into a maximum of three wells, including fluids associated with conventional oil production into well #1, and ambient air for enhanced oil recovery purposes into well #3, located in Sections 16, 20, and 21, T7N, R57E, in Nye County. The applicant is required to monitor injection pressure, annular pressure and rate, and to conduct periodic mechanical integrity tests of the wells. The injection zone has been characterized as a hydrocarbon producing zone. Injection pressure will not exceed that allowable per regulation.

On the basis of preliminary review, the Administrator has made a tentative determination to issue the UIC permit to authorize water discharge activities.

Persons wishing to comment on or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance or to request a hearing pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments in writing by December 22, 2014 either in person or by mail to: Nevada Division of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Water Pollution Control, Attn: Russ Land, 901 South Stewart Street; Suite 4001, Carson City, NV 89701

All comments or objections received within thirty days of newspaper publication will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty days prior to the hearing date.
