

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 445B, the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 445B, and the Clean Air Act, the Division of Environmental Protection is issuing the following Notice of Proposed Action.

The Director received an application for a new Class 1 (Title V) Air Quality Operating Permit, AP4953-3547 (FIN A0017) from the following applicant:

City of Fallon – Russell Pass Landfill is located in Churchill County, at approximately 17 miles south of Fallon of US 95 near Russell Pass, Fallon, Nevada, in Churchill County. The project is located in all or portions of the following area: Section 21, Township 16N, Range 29E (MDB&M). The Director has prepared a tentative determination regarding the new Class 1 (Title V) Air Quality Operating Permit that, in brief, includes the following:

-The function of the Russell Pass Landfill is for the disposal of municipal, commercial and industrial solid waste, and petroleum contaminated soils. The design capacity of the Russell Pass Landfill is 8.025 million megagrams (Mg) of solid waste. The new Class I (Title V) Air Quality Operating Permit replaces the existing Class I (Title V) Air Quality Operating Permit because the facility did not submit a renewal application within the appropriate timeframe.

On the basis of the preliminary review and the requirements of the NRS, the NAC and the Clean Air Act, the Director is hereby announcing her intent to issue the Class 1 (Title V) Air Quality Operating Permit based on a review of the information submitted. A copy of the draft permit will be available for public inspection at the following location:
