## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION - Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation

**Web Posting: 08/15/2014**

**Deadline for Comment: 09/14/2014**

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection (the Division) gives notice that an application for a renewal of a Water Pollution Control Permit for the **Marigold Project**, a mining and beneficiation facility, has been properly filed with the Division of Environmental Protection in Carson City. The Applicant for the modification to **Water Pollution Control Permit NEV0088040** (Permit) is:

The facility is located on both public and private land in Humboldt County, within portions of Section 36, Township 34 North, Range 42 East; Sections 1, 12, 13, 24, 25, and 36, Township 33 North, Range 42 East; Sections 19, 20, 21, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, and 33, Township 34 North, Range 43 East; Sections 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 30, and 31, Township 33 North, Range 43 East; and Section 6, Township 32 North, Range 43 East; Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian (MDB&M), approximately 30 miles southeast (by air) of the city of Winnemucca, Nevada.

The project consists of a surface mine and a chemical beneficiation facility, designed to extract gold from gold-bearing ores, with a maximum permitted production rate of 25 million tons of ore per year. The facility is comprised of several open pits, waste rock dumps, a cyanide heap leach facility, a mill, tailings impoundment, solution ponds and monitoring devices. Facilities are required to be designed, constructed, operated and closed without any discharge or release in excess of those standards established in regulation except for meteorological events which exceed the design storm event.

The Administrator is constrained to either issue the renewal Permit or to deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the renewal Permit.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed Permit, to recommend terms and conditions for consideration of incorporation into the Permit, or who request a public hearing pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 445A, must submit their written comments, objections, or requests by hand delivery or US Postal Service, or by facsimile or e-mail transmittal (with the original to be received within five (5) days of transmittal date), no later

than 5:00 PM on the 30<sup>th</sup> day following the date of publication of this notice (publication date 15 August 2014, submittal end date 14 September 2014) to:

All comments, objections, or requests received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding the Permit. If the Division determines written comments or requests indicate a significant degree of public interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 445A.405.
