North Monitor Exploration Project - Discharge Permit

Barrick Gold Exploration Inc.

The Administrator of the State of Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (the Division) has decided to issue Authorization to Discharge NEV2014118 to Barrick Gold Exploration Inc. This Permit authorizes the construction, operation, and closure of a mineral exploration program in Eureka County, Nevada. The Division has been provided with sufficient information, in accordance with Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445A.350 through 445A.447, to assure that the waters of the State will not be degraded by this operation, and that public safety and health will be protected.

The Permit will become effective 13 November 2014. The final determination of the Administrator may be appealed to the State Environmental Commission pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 445A.605 and NAC 445A.407. All requests for appeals must be filed by 5:00 PM, 8 November 2014, on Form 3, with the State Environmental Commission, 901 South Stewart Street, Suite 4001, Carson City, Nevada 89701-5249.
