

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following Notice of Proposed Action under the authority of the Nevada Revised Statutes, the Nevada Administrative Code, and the Safe Drinking Water Act.

The Administrator has received a major modification application for Underground Injection Control (UIC) permit UNEV2009202 and is seeking comments. This permit has been applied for by the following applicant:

Truckee Meadows Water Authority, 1355 Capital Blvd. Reno, Nevada 89520

The applicant has requested modification of the permit associated with injection of surface water from the drinking water distribution system for purposes of aquifer storage and recovery in the southern area of Spanish Springs Valley. This injection is needed to recharge the aquifer and store available surface water. The application is requesting to increase the number of injection wells from one (1) to nine (9), located in the Section 3 T20N, R20E, Sections 6 and 7 T20N R21E and Section 34 T21N R 20E MDB&M.

Monitoring will be required under the permit to ensure degradation of groundwater does not occur. On the basis of preliminary review, the Administrator has made a tentative determination to modify the UIC permit to authorize injection activities.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance or to request a hearing pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request in writing by September 21, 2015 either in person or by mail to: Nevada Division of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Water Pollution Control, Attn: Russ Land, 901 South Stewart Street; Suite 4001, Carson City, NV 89701-5249, rland@ndep.nv.gov

All comments or objections received within thirty days of newspaper publication will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty days prior to the hearing date.
