NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION - Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation

Deadline for Comment: 03/16/2015

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection (the Division) gives notice that an application for a new Water Pollution Control Permit for the **Long Canyon Project**, a mining and beneficiation facility, has been properly filed with the Division of Environmental Protection in Carson City. The Applicant for Water Pollution Control Permit **NEV2014110** (Permit) is:

The facility is located on public and private land in Elko County, within Sections 24 and 25, Township 36 North, Range 65 East; Sections 11 through 15, 17, and 19 through 36, Township 36 North, Range 66 East; Sections 1 through 6 and 9 through 16, Township 35 North, Range 66 East; Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian, approximately 27 miles east of Wells, Nevada and 31 miles west of West Wendover, Nevada.

The Project consists of a surface mining and chemical beneficiation facility, pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445A.350 through 445A.447, designed to extract gold, with a maximum permitted production rate of 5,000,000 tons of ore per year. The facility is comprised of mine, heap leach facility, waste rock storage facility, process ponds, gold recovery facility, wells, and associated ancillary facilities. Facilities are required to be designed, constructed, operated, and closed without any discharge or release in excess of those standards established in regulation except for meteorological events which exceed the design storm event.

The Administrator is constrained to either issue the new Permit or to deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the new Permit.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed Permit, to recommend terms and conditions for consideration of incorporation into the Permit, or who request a public hearing pursuant to NAC 445A, must submit their written comments, objections, or requests by hand delivery or US Postal Service, or by facsimile or e-mail transmittal, no later than 5:00 PM on the 30th day following the date of publication of this notice (publication date 14 February 2015, submittal end date 16 March 2015) to:

All comments, objections, or requests received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding the Permit. If the Division determines written comments or requests indicate a significant degree of public interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 445A.405.

The draft Permit and all application documents are on file at the Division and are available for public inspection and copying pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute 445A.665.
