



NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and/or the Clean Water Act, where applicable. The Administrator has received an application for a Manufacturing, Commercial, Mining and Silvicultural facility that discharges NON-PROCESS Wastewater , permit number NV0022942 from the following applicant:

Permit NV0022942, LLOYD D. GEORGE FEDERAL COURTHOUSE:

The Permittee has applied for renewal of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit NV0022942, to continue to discharge 49,500 gallons per day of treated groundwater from the Lloyd D. George United States Courthouse (Courthouse) to the Las Vegas Wash via the storm drain system and Las Vegas Creek. Permanent dewatering of the Courthouse is required to prevent flooding of sub-level parking and basement areas. Treatment is required because shallow groundwater in this area is reportedly contaminated with benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene, xylene, and perchloroethylene, and petroleum hydrocarbons. Monitoring of the treated discharge is conducted to ensure that surface waters are not degraded as a result of the discharge. Discharge of stormwater from the basement parking garage through and oil-water separator is also included in this permit.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue Permit NV0022942 to discharge for a five (5) year period, subject to certain effluent limitations.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, hand delivered or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. on 12/14/2015 , either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s) regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
