

NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 445B, the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 445B, and the Clean Air Act, the Division of Environmental Protection is issuing the following Notice of Proposed Action.

The Director received an application for a new Class I Air Quality Operating Permit to Construct (OPTC) AP3241-3431 (FIN A0030) from the following applicant:

Nevada Cement Company is located off of Exit 46 on Interstate 80 in Fernley, Nevada, which is in Lyon County, in all or portions of Sections 10 & 11, Township 20N, Range 24E, M.D.B. & M. The Director has prepared a tentative determination regarding the operating permit that, in brief, includes the following:

Nevada Cement Company is proposing an alternative mode of operation for each of the kilns to burn post-consumer carpet fuel in combination with coal and coal/coke. Nevada Cement Company is requesting the ability to burn up to 2.5 tons per hour (tph) of post-consumer carpet fuel and up to 7.5 tph of coal and/or coal/coke (maximum heat input rate of 186.0 MMBtu/hr) for each kiln. Nevada Cement Company will be subject to 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 60 – Standards of Performance for New Stationary Sources – Subpart DDDD – Emissions Guidelines and Compliance Times for Commercial and Industrial Solid Waste Incineration Units under the conditions of this OPTC.

On the basis of the preliminary review and the requirements of the NRS, the NAC and the Clean Air Act, the Director is hereby announcing his intent to issue the new Class I Air Quality Operating Permit to Construct based on a review of the information, as proposed.
