



NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and/or the Clean Water Act, where applicable. The Administrator has received an application for a Groundwater Discharge, permit number NS0099002 from the following applicant:

Permit NS0099002, TPC LAS VEGAS GOLF COURSE

The Tournament Players Club (TPC) at the Canyons operates The Canyons Golf Course, located at 9801 Canyon Run Drive in the Northwest area of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada. This facility has one regulation 18-hole course, and covers approximately 110 acres. The facility uses one reservoir fed by the recycled water supply line for storage of irrigation water. There are no other water features at this facility.

TPC – The Canyons receives effluent from the Durango Hills Water Resource Center (DHWRC) wastewater treatment facility for irrigation of turf, greens and landscaped areas. The DHWRC is regulated under NDEP Permit NS0098005. The DHWRC recycled water is blended with potable water to provide the course with the volume of water required. The relative percentages of potable and recycled water will vary with the seasonal irrigation demand.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue Permit NS0099002 to discharge for a five (5) year period, subject to certain effluent limitations.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, hand delivered or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. on 05/25/2016, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s) regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
