## NEVADA DIVISION OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

### COMMUNICATION PROTOCOL

#### BETWEEN THE TRIBAL-STATE ENVIRONMENTAL LIAISON OFFICE

This protocol is intended to be the guideline to be followed where tribal involvement is necessary such as environmental issues, jurisdiction, and identification of tribal contacts.

#### **ORGANIZATION:**

The Tribal-State Environmental Liaison Office was developed to enhance the working relationship between Nevada Tribal Governments and the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP). The Liaison has the task to advise Nevada Tribes and the NDEP Administrator on the regulatory requirements of environmental protection. In addition, with tribal and state approval, the Liaison will initiate recommendations of actions to the tribes and NDEP for the strengthening of tribal programmatic, regulatory and enforcement components of environmental protection. See attached Position and Role documentation for specific duties of the Liaison.

#### **ACTIONS FOR COMMUNICATION WITH TRIBAL-STATE ENVIRONMENTAL LIAISON OFFICE:**

1. Contact Liaison at 687-9483 or cell phone 315-4346 dependent on the urgency of the issue
2. Contact Liaison with accurate and precise details of the issue as it pertains to tribes in Nevada. Details should include the following:
  - a. Date
  - b. Time
  - c. Place
  - d. Nature of Issue
    - i. Environmental issue
    - ii. General question
    - iii. Immediate reply
3. All written correspondence to and from tribes should be cc to the Liaison to ensure all information is received prior to scheduling of meetings, conference calls or follow-up occurs.
4. Unless otherwise specified by the tribes. Documented authorization must be submitted to the Liaison in this case.
5. E-mail correspondence will be accepted for details on a specific issue, but must provide time and date that the response is needed marked with high importance.
