



## **Public Notice – Request for Comment: New Solid Waste Management Facility**

The Administrator of the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (Division) gives notice, under the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 444.440 through 444.620, inclusive, and under the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 444.570 through 444.7499, inclusive, that the Division has received a request to issue a solid waste management facility permit to construct and operate a medical waste pyrolysis facility from the following applicant:

MediWaste Disposal LLC

MediWaste Disposal LLC has requested to operate an medical waste pyrolysis facility in Pahrump, Nevada. The facility is located in central Pahrump, situated within an established corridor near the intersection of East Basin Avenue and Highway 160. The Administrator is constrained to either issue the permit or deny the request in accordance with NAC 444.641. The Administrator is issuing this notice of intent to issue the Permit to the applicant.

The applicant or any interested persons may submit written comments on the proposed permit issuance. The 30-day comment period will begin on **April 1, 2026 at 8:00 a.m.** and end on May 1, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. Written comments must be submitted no later than **5:00 pm on May 1, 2026.** Written comments should be:

The Draft Permit and Application are available for review at the above address. Additional information may also be available for review on the Division website: <https://ndep.nv.gov/posts/category/public-notice> and on OnBase at <https://ndep-onbase.nv.gov/>. All comments received by the end of the 30-day public comment period will be considered in the permit decision. The Administrator may extend the period for public comment if deemed necessary.

Within 30 days after the end of the public comment period, the Administrator will either issue or deny the permit to operate the waste tire recycling facility, or may modify, or place conditions on, the permit issued in accordance with NAC 444.6425. A copy of the final permit decision will be sent to the applicant and all persons who submitted written comments.
