



## **NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION - Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation**

**Reclamation Permit 0430  
Hog Ranch Minerals Inc.  
Hog Ranch Exploration Project**

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection has decided to issue Reclamation Permit (0430) for an Exploration Project to Hog Ranch Minerals Inc. This Permit authorizes the Permittee to reclaim the Hog Ranch Exploration Project located in Washoe County, Nevada. The Division has been provided with an application, in accordance with Nevada Revised Statutes and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 519A to assure the Division that the Permittee will leave the project site safe, stable, and capable of providing for a productive post-mining land use.

This Permit will become effective June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024. The final determination of the Administrator may be appealed to the State Environmental Commission (Commission) pursuant to NAC 519A.415. All requests for appeals must be filed by 5:00 PM, June 21, 2024, on Form 3 with the Commission at 901 South Stewart Street, Suite 4001, Carson City, Nevada 89701-5249, and in accordance with administrative rules of the Commission.

This Permit authorizes 200 acres of surface disturbance, 0.1 private acres and 199.99 public acres on land administered by the Bureau of Land Management, as described in the permit application dated November 2023, Hog Ranch Exploration Project. The project has proposed a phased bonding approach.
