TEMPORARY DISCHARGE PERMIT APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

PROCEDURES FOR FILING – A form fill version of the application is available at the Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation website at http://ndep.nv.gov/bmrr. Additional information sufficient to describe and explain the proposed activity must be included with the completed form, Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445A.230. Contents of the supporting information are detailed in the regulations governing temporary discharge permits, NAC 445A.228 through 445A.263.

<u>SIGNATURE ON APPLICATION</u> - The permit application must be signed by the owner or, for partnership or corporation, an executive officer whose name appears in Part 1. If the owner does not operate the facility then the operator or his designated agent must also sign the application, NAC 445A.231.

<u>USE OF INFORMATION</u> - All information contained in this application will, upon request, be made available to the public for inspection and copying.

<u>APPLICABILITY</u> – This application applies only to waters that are not waters of the U.S. If the proposed temporary discharge will be to a water of the U.S., then the applicant must apply to the Bureau of Water Pollution Control.

The discharge for well pump tests does not require a permit if the following three (3) conditions are met: 1) The discharge is less than 250 gallons per minute; 2) The test is for less than 48 hours in duration; and 3) The discharge water will not cause a violation of any water quality standard.

A temporary permit may be issued for a 180-day maximum period of time, pursuant to Nevada Revised Statues (NRS) 445A.485, after which time the discharge shall cease or the discharger shall have applied for and received a five (5) year Discharge Permit, NRS 445A.495. A \$250.00 fee is due at the time of application, NAC 445A.232.

TEMPORARY DISCHARGE PERMIT APPLICATION

A temporary permit may be issued once for a 180-day maximum period of time, pursuant to Nevada Revised Statues (NRS) 445A.485, after which time the discharge shall cease or the discharger shall have applied for and received a five (5) year Discharge Permit, NRS 445A.495. A \$250.00 fee is due at the time of application, NAC 445A.232.
