RE: Stormwater Pond Liner Replacement 21st Century Environmental Management of Nevada

Dear Neighbors,

21st Century Environmental Management of Nevada (21st EMN) is pleased to report on the complete stormwater replacement project. The project with all finishing work and associated clean up was completed on June 30, 2025 the actual installation of the liner was completed on June 25, 2025.

The Department was notified on June 3, 2025, that 21st EMN intended to replace the upper liner of the stormwater retention pond and a Formal Class 1 Modification was submitted June 4, 2025. NDEP approved the Modification on June 12, 2025 with conditions. On June 16, 2025 the pond liner removal and replacement commenced.

General Manager Modesto Granados performed daily inspections ensuring that there were no observable leaks from the upper liner and that construction was proceeding as planned. The liner was completed on June 25, 2025 and the final finishing work, clean up, and final inspection were completed on June 30, 2025.

On July 25, 2025 the Certified as Built drawings, Integrity Test Report, Photos and verification statement of the condition of the secondary liner, field reports of the liner installation activities were provided to NDEP. Finally on July 28, 2025 NDEP determined 21EMN's response fulfills the requirements of the Schedule of Compliance items.

The Evaporation Pond Completion Documentation was provided by Patrick Hsieh of Dalton, Olmsted, and Fuglevand. The attachment provided to NDEP is titled Clean Earth Fernley SW Pond Memo 25-07-25 Final. It includes Certified as Built drawings, Integrity Test Report, Photos and verification statement of the condition of the secondary liner, and field reports of the liner installation activities.

The function of the stormwater retention pond is to collect any and all precipitation that may fall on the active portion of 21st Century Environmental Management's Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage, and Disposal facility. This ensures that there is no possibility of contaminated rainwater leaving the facility. Water is evaporated and residue is managed as hazardous waste
