The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) gives notice that an application for renewal of a Water Pollution Control Permit for the **Long Canyon Mine**, a mining and beneficiation facility, has been properly filed with the NDEP in Carson City. The Applicant for renewal of Water Pollution Control Permit **NEV2014110** (Permit) is:

Nevada Gold Mines, LLC 1655 Mountain City Highway Elko, NV 89801

The facility is located on public and private land in in Elko County, within Sections 24 and 25, Township 36 North, Range 65 East; Sections 11 through 15, 17, and 19 through 36, Township 36 North, Range 66 East; Sections 1 through 6 and 9 through 16, Township 35 North, Range 66 East; Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian, approximately 27 miles east of Wells, Nevada and 31 miles west of Wendover, Nevada.

The Project consists of an open pit mining facility and chemical processing facility, pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445A.394.

The Administrator is constrained to either issue the renewed Permit or deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the renewed Permit.

Persons wishing to comment on the proposed Permit, recommend terms and conditions for consideration of incorporation into the Permit, or request a public hearing pursuant to NAC 445A.403 must submit their written comments, objections, or requests by hand delivery, U.S. Postal Service, facsimile, or e-mail transmittal, no later than 5:00 PM on the 30<sup>th</sup> day following the date of publication of this notice (submittal end date **May 29 2025**) to:

All comments, objections, or requests received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding the Permit. If NDEP determines that written comments or requests indicate a significant degree of public interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 445A.405.
